- The club goal is to create the best opportunity for individual player development and team competitiveness.
- Create competitive teams by birth year or by combined birth years based on individual team competitive or travel priorities.
- Teams can be formed based on tryouts and/or selections based on prior year evaluations and performance.
- Additional factors that must be considered when creating teams are the unique challenges that our rural club faces: geographic, demographic and IHSAA constraints (limited to 7 players from the same high school team on a travel team).
- What works for one age group or gender may not work for the other, and may change from year to year.

SPRING 2023 TEAM EXPECTATIONS

ISFC 2013, 2014 TEAMS (U10):

- Focus on the development of players and individual skills
- Practices 2 times per week
- 8-10 friendlies (Jasper, Washington and Evansville) (U10 may consider ISL)
- 1-2 local travel soccer tournament (Owensboro or Evansville)
- Estimated costs: 0 \$320-\$530 fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - \$138 uniform (if needed)

ISFC 2011, 2012 TEAMS (U12, U11):

- Focus on the development of players and individual skills
- Practices 2 times per week
- 8-10 ISL/EASA league games (Jasper, Washington and Evansville)
- 2 local travel soccer tournament (southern Indiana, northern Kentucky)
- Option for 1+ out of town travel soccer tournament
- Estimated costs: 0 \$360-\$590 fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - o \$150 uniform (if needed)

ISFC 2008, 2009, 2010 TEAMS (U15, U14, U13):

- Focus on the development of team play, competitive play, continued player development
- Practices 2 3 times per week
- 8-10 ISL league games (southern Indiana)
- 1-2 local travel soccer tournaments (southern Indiana, northern Kentucky)
- At least 1 or more out of town travel soccer tournament
- Estimated costs: 0 \$400-\$700 fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - o \$150 uniform (if needed)

ISFC 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 TEAMS (U19, U18, U17, U16):

- Focus on the development of team play, competitive play, continued player development
- Practices 2 3 times per week
- 8-10 ISL league games (Indiana locations based on ISL division/play group)
- 1-2 local travel soccer tournaments (southern Indiana, northern Kentucky)
- At least 1 out of town travel soccer tournament
- At least 1 college showcase tournament (U16, U17, U18, U19)
- Estimated costs: 0 \$415-\$730 fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - o \$150 uniform (if needed)

ALL TEAMS:

- Indoor conditioning varies by team
- Outdoor practices begin no later than early March for all teams (2-3 days per week)
- The Indiana Soccer League season begins March 19, 2023 and ends June 5, 2023 (games & tournaments typically occur between those dates). All players attend games and tournaments scheduled by their teams.
- Player payments/fees will be collected in 2-3 equal payments (December, January and February)
- Team meetings are held no later than early December
